

NOTICE OF PROPOSITION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE OLIVE RESIDENTS LOCATED
IN THE PROPOSED SHOKAN SEWER DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the proposition described below will be held on Saturday, September 24, 2022, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Qualified voters are to vote at the American Legion Hall, located at 26 Mountain Road, in the Hamlet of Shokan, Town of Olive.

The proposition is:

SHALL the qualified electors located in the proposed Sewer District of the Town of Olive, in the County of Ulster, approve the Resolution, adopted by the Town Board of the said Town on the 14th day of June, 2022, which resolution authorizes the establishment of a sewer district with the general boundaries of said proposed sewer district being those properties located in the Hamlet of Shokan. The cost to construct the new wastewater treatment plant, collection system to serve the residents within the proposed sewer district and related improvements are being funded through the Community Wastewater Management Program with Funds received from the City of New York and administered by the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC). No local funds will be spent. Once constructed, the operation of the sewer system will be funded primarily by City of New York with the remainder funded by the households within the sewer districts (\$100 per household per year with adjustment for inflation after three years) and by non-households within the sewer district (minimum annual charge of \$250 plus an additional amount based upon flow; median annual charge to a non-household within the district averaging 150 gallons per day is estimated at \$589 per year). The sewer district will own and be responsible for the sewer system. A Special Benefit Assessment will apply to new construction connecting to the sewer system (i.e., construction on vacant lots within the District that did not have a septic system closed hereunder).
