Resolution Authorizing the Removal of Street Lights by Central Hudson

**WHEREAS**, the New York City Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Engineering Design and Construction, is replacing the Route 28A Esopus Creek bridge and the Route 28A railroad bridge in Boiceville, and

**WHEREAS**, the bridge replacement project known as CAT-252, will also redesign and re-construct the intersection of NYS Route 28A and Route 28 in Boiceville, NY, and

**WHEREAS**, the construction of this intersection will require the removal of two street lights located on poles #133854 and #182828 (K66199) owned and maintained by Central Hudson for the Town of Olive, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Olive, authorizes the Supervisor to sign a Street Light Authority Order with Central Hudson for the removal of two street lights in Boiceville at the intersection of NYS Route 28 and NYS Route 28A.
