TITLE OF LOGO SUBMISSION:

Judging Criteria: originality and creativity; successful application of the Olive Day Bicentennial theme; quality of craftsmanship in chosen medium

Theme: All entrants should include the Olive Day mascot, a frog, and "2023 Olive Day Bicentennial" in the design.

Entry Form & Method of Submissions: An Official Entry Form will be available at the Olive Free Library, online at the Olive Free Library website, and at the Town of Olive Town Hall. Entries must be submitted in .pdf or .tiff format, in 300 dpi or greater. Multiple submissions are allowed.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received at the Olive Free Library by Monday, October 31, 2022, whether delivered by hand, mailed, or emailed. The Olive Day Bicentennial Committee's decisions are final.

Eligibility and Guidelines:

1. All submissions must be created by the sender
2. The winning logo will best represent the 2023 Olive Day Bicentennial Celebration
3. Entrants must be residents of the Town of Olive
4. The deadline for entries is Monday, October 31, 2022
5. Entries should be submitted using the Contest Application Form.
6. Up to three entries may be submitted by one entrant. Each entry must include the artist's name, address, phone number, email address and age.
7. Flexibility of the design: logos must be easily resized; look good in black and white, grayscale and color; and be suitable for high-quality printing. Logos should be emailed in .pdf format with a 300 dpi or higher resolution.
8. Logos must be original artwork. Logos must not in any way use existing or otherwise copyrighted material such as artwork, screenshots, clip art, etc.
9. The winning logo will be the property of the Olive Day Bicentennial Committee and will be published, displayed, and reproduced in a variety of media formats, including but not limited to: programs, promotional materials, websites, social media, newspapers, brochures, posters, banners, signs, and t-shirts.
10. The winning artist will be published and promoted, and will receive artist credit, a t-shirt with the logo on it and a \$50 Contest Prize
11. By submitting an entry, the entrant agrees to abide by the Olive Day Bicentennial Committee design contest guidelines, submission requirements, and decisions.
12. The logo must not exploit or offend anyone's sex, race, religion, gender, nationality, morality, culture, and must not be salacious or pornographic.
