All Social Services districts are required to provide an emergency fuel plan for after-hours, holidays, and weekends when the Agency is closed. The 2022 - 2023 after-hours procedure is detailed on second page of this letter.

All after-hours heating emergencies, other than in the City of Kingston, are referred to the Ulster County Sheriff. Emergencies within the City of Kingston are referred to the Kingston Police Department. The Sheriff's Office/Kingston Police Department will contact the elected official seeking their assistance. If the official is not able to meet the emergency using local resources, the official will contact ABC Fuels, ACE Oil or Mazzola Oil for an emergency delivery of fuel to meet the need until the next business day.

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) opened on November 1, 2022 and is expected to close March 15, 2023. The HEAP Heating Equipment Repair & Replacement Program (HERR) is also in effect at this time.

2022 - 2023 After-Hours Fuel Emergency Program

The After-Hours Fuel Emergency Program covers fuel emergencies when the Ulster County Department of Social Services is closed. Social Services business hours are Monday – Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. This program meets the basic emergency to cover fuel until the next business day.

Referrals for this emergency program can be made after regular business hours, holidays, and weekends. All calls, except within the city of Kingston, are referred to the Ulster County Sheriff's Office. Referrals within the City of Kingston should be directed to the Kingston Police Department.

The Ulster County Sheriff's Office or the Kingston Police Department will contact the local elected official within the city or town. If the elected official is not able to meet the emergency fuel need, the official contacts are listed below.
